"Meatfare" is a week of consuming all the meat in one's home in preparation for the Great Fast. Traditionally, Byzantine Catholics abstain from meat and dairy products for the entire Fast. Knowing this can be a wrenching experience, we ease into total abstinence, and enjoy the last week's of Pre-Lent, by consuming all the meat in the house this week, and all the dairy in the house next week.

All Souls Saturdays: We have 5 All Souls Saturdays to commemorate our dead relatives. The first All Souls Saturday will be on February 6th, 2021. Envelopes "All Souls Saturdays" are available in the narthex of the church.
