7-DAY CANDLE OFFERING: If you would like to offer the 7-day candle for the intention of your family, friends, or loved ones, please use an envelope marked "7-Day Candle Request" found in the narthex and put it in Sunday's collection basket. Lamps are lit the following week after the Saturday Liturgy and the intention is published in the Parish Bulletin.

Blessing of Students: On Sunday, June 6, we will pray for graduates and students of Schools, Colleges, Universities. If you, your neighbors or your friends have a graduate or a student of any type, invite them to the Divine Liturgy. At the end of the Liturgy, a Moleben and blessing of the graduates and students will be celebrated.

The Apostles' (sometimes called the Peter and Paul Fast) Fast begins tomorrow, May 31st and continues until their feast day on June 29th. The traditional fasting discipline (no meat, poultry, meat by-products, eggs, dairy, fish, wine, olive oil, and their by products) is observed on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays; and (no meat, poultry, meat by-products, eggs, dairy, and their by-products) is observed on Tuesdays, Thursdays, Saturdays and Sundays.

Memorial Day: Tomorrow is the civic observance of Memorial Day to honor those who died in service to the United States. Following the Divine Liturgy tomorrow, we will celebrate a panachida for the repose of those who died in service to our country.

Reception of Holy Communion: Please remember only CATHOLIC CHRISTIANS who have PREPARED themselves may partake of Holy Communion. "But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of the bread and drink of the cup. For he who eats and drinks in an unworthy manner eats and drinks judgment to himself, not discerning the Lord's body." (1 Corinthians 11:28-29).
