Today, after Divine Liturgy we will have a procession of the Holy Cross and also we will bless water and honey.

The Feast of the Transfiguration of Our Lord: On Friday, August 6, we will celebrate the Divine Liturgy of the Transfiguration, followed by the blessing of fruit. We bless the first fruit of the harvest as a giving back to the Lord what is His and has come from Him. We ask you to bring your own basket of fruit to the church to be blessed. A table will be set up in the front of the church for baskets to be blessed.

The cores and the peel of fruit should be buried in the garden and not thrown in the rubbish bin.

This same truth is still true today as we begin this Dormition Fast. To see this more clearly, we need men and women of faith to serve the Church as priests, deacons, subdeacons, monks and nuns. The Dormition Fast: The traditional rule for the Dormition Fast is a strict abstinence from August 1 to 14, with the usual mitigations (wine and oil) for Saturday and Sunday and the Feast of the Transfiguration (August 6). It is, therefore, observed as the Great Fast. However, the Ruthenian Metropolia has identified this period as a penitential season (Canon 880, § 2).

According to the Pastoral Handbook simple fast or abstinence forbids the use of meat and meat products, but does not forbid the use of eggs and dairy products. Simple fast or abstinence is required on all Fridays. It is also highly recommended on Wednesdays.
