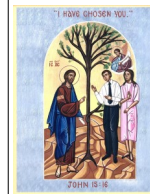
Topic: Rejoice all Ye Peoples: The Feasts of the Old Testament

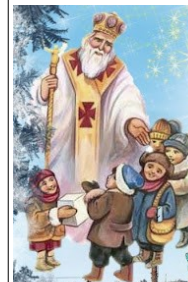


Pray for Vocation!
