Volunteers needed: We need volunteers to help us with undecorating of our church and hall next Sunday January 16 after Divine Liturgy. Thank you for your help.

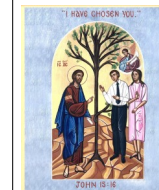
